Just a reminder the pilot boxes are not there for a suggestion, they are where you have to be if you are on the flight line. On this same line, flying is to be east of the pilot stands. Flying over the pits is not allowed. This is not up for debate. Carrying on, the use of any First Person Viewing devices on any aircraft can not be used without a spotter that is an AMA member and has to have a club membership. The spotter's duties are to maintain visual contact with the aircraft and alert the pilot of any other aircraft or possible dangers for the aircraft or pilot in the area. The spotter will also not allow the pilot to fly over the pits or out of the boundaries of the flying field. The spotter must also be able to take over flying the aircraft in the event that the pilot becomes unable to do so. If for some reason we as a club can't abide by these policies the use of First Person Viewing devices will not be allowed at the LSK field. We are all in this together, one guy screws it up we ALL loose the field. We have a lot of hard work and \$70k plus invested in this club. Don't mess it up by thinking you don't have to go along with the idea we are all responsible for this place. If any of this bothers you come to the meeting and state your case. On that happy note, go out there and have fun and fly safe.

New Members

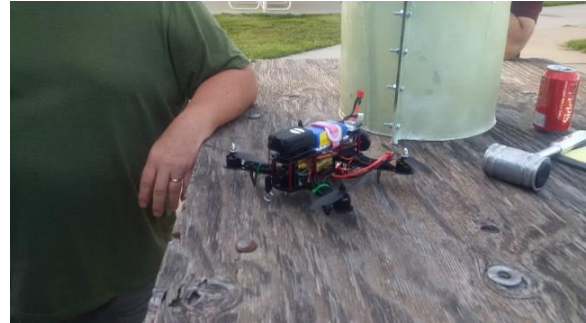
John Waterman was welcomed into the Sky knights WELCOME!

Mike had an F16 ducted fan and Jim showed off his quad copter with camera. Alan Zinnecker brought a fiberglass cowl on his latest project.

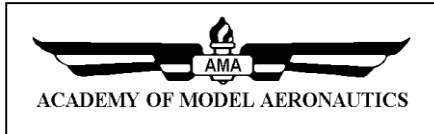
