**Model of the Month:** Dave Reiber brought his Quickie 500 racer. It is a Predator with a Nelson racing engine on it that turns 18,500 RPM and weighs 4 1/2 pounds. It has a molded carbon fiber wing with one spar running through the wing that is extremely strong. All the joints are sealed with tape to make it as slippery as possible. The throw on the ailerons is only 3/16 of an inch on HIGH rates. It uses a bladder tank that puts the muffler pressure into the solid outside tank outside the bladder. The fuel is provided and is 15% nitro. You race for ten laps which is 2 1/2 miles in one minute and seven seconds.
